Spencer Beach

Spencer went to work one day when a chemical he was working with ignited and created a flash fire. With a whistle and a bang he received severe burns to 87% of his body, was given a 5% Chance to live, his whole identity changed and the effects of his incident rippled out to everyone in his life – especially his wife Tina who was four months pregnant with their first child. Join him as he shares how he went from being a burn survivor to an “extremely hot man”.

Curtis Weber

Curtis shares his personal experience as a young worker severely injured on the job. Curtis sustained burns to over 60% of his body. His right arm and left leg had to be amputated. He will share his personal story of a workplace injury, talk about rights and responsibilities in the workplace and put a positive twist on a serious injury.
